

THE CHAUTAUQUA CENTER'S BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES REMAIN OPEN DURING COVID-19

Dunkirk, NY: The Chautauqua Center has set up new protocols to ensure that behavioral health services remain in place for those seeking mental health and chemical dependency treatment during the COVID-19 outbreak. Clinics in Dunkirk and Jamestown will remain open for those in the community who wish to access treatment.

- Do you have any respiratory symptoms?
- Do you have a fever?
- Have you traveled outside of the United States or New York State in the last 14 days?
- Have you been diagnosed with COVID-19 or have you been in close contact with anyone who may have coronavirus or COVID-19 virus in the last 14 days?
