Know Your Rights: Housing Support



What financial support is available for housing?

Care Coordinators can help you find resources related to paying rent or securing and maintaining community living arrangements. They can also assist with finding resources related to utility payments (gas, electric, heat), managed budget billing, and access to food through public benefits.



What in-home supports are there?

Care Coordinators can apply for environmental modifications to make your home more accessible. They can discuss options to help you live safely and independently in your home by using technologies to support everyday activities.



What additional resources can help me live comfortably?

Care Coordinators can help you access home aid support. They can also identify more affordable furnishings and household items, and make referrals to pest control as needed.



What are my responsibilities?

You have the responsibility to pay your portion of your rent and utility bills. You also have the responsibility to allow your Care Coordinator into your home. Be sure to bring up concerns to your Care Coordinator as they arise so they know how to best help you. You should also follow up with any requests made by your Care Coordinator so they have the information they need to assist.
